3. What you must not do

- encourage or assist anything that breaks the law.

5. Suspension and Termination

5.1. If we think you have breached this policy, we will take whatever steps we think are necessary. These might include:



- stopping your use of the Website or Learning and Collaboration Platform temporarily or permanently.
- removing material you have put onto the Website and Collaboration Platform;
- sending you a warning;
- taking legal action;
- reporting incidents to the relevant authorities.
